

Invitation to Judge
from the
Virginia Junior Academy of Science

The Virginia Junior Academy of Science will hold its 2010 Annual Meeting in conjunction with the Virginia Academy of Science at James Madison University, May 20. The purpose of this meeting is to give approximately 750 students in grades seven through twelve from throughout the commonwealth the opportunity to present papers, which will report original research they have conducted. On Thursday, twenty-two papers will be presented every 15 minutes from 9 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. You will be invited to come early that morning to prepare for the arrival of the young scientists. A detailed schedule of events will follow in April with the delivery of their papers for your review.

How can we accomplish this goal? In order to achieve this monumental task many volunteers are needed. Each of the sections requires three judges and a chair. Judges are needed in all fields: Agriculture & Animal Science, Animal Behavior, Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Consumer Science, Earth & Space Science, Engineering, Environmental Science, Genetics & Cellular Biology, Math, Medicine & Health, Microbiology, Physical Science (middle school), Physics (high school), Psychology (general, learning and perception, and social), Statistics, and Zoology.

Judging requires one to read and evaluate no more than twenty-two papers, which will be received approximately three weeks prior to the date of the meeting. The judges are asked to be present, with those papers, at a briefing. Breakfast will be offered earlier that morning but will not be at the same location as the Judges Overview Meeting. If you are interested in a breakfast in their café then please indicate below. Judges and chairs will also receive lunch and can choose to be a representative at "Dinner with a Scientist" at which the scientists can interact with the student.

Please help us to make another exciting VJAS Annual Conference happen. If you are interested in helping out then, please register today so we can secure your first choice in category. Please fill out and mail the bottom portion of this letter to Ms. Susan Booth. You will, at a later date, receive notification of the category you will be judging, parking permits, scoring rubric, schedule, and other important information in the mail. We will update you with more details as the logistics of the annual meeting are worked out and will have this information available on-line as well at www.vjas.org.
